

**A RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO HB 903 REGARDING  
EXTENSION OF HOTEL/MOTEL TAX CONTRIBUTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell, Georgia is a Georgia municipal corporation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council are the governing authority of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor and Council are charged with the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Roswell; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor and Council have reviewed proposed State legislation, namely House Bill 903, which if adopted will extend the hotel/motel tax expenditure toward the Georgia Dome project or its successor until the year 2050; and



**WHEREAS**, Mayor and Council believe this State legislation is not in the best interest of the newly incorporated cities in Fulton County:



Let a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to all state legislators serving the City of Roswell.




