RESOLUTION SEEKING APPROVAL TO ACCEPT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) - RECOVERY 2009 NORCROSS STREET DRAINAGE & SWAYBRANCH STREET WATERLINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 2nd of November, 2009, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to accept the terms and conditions of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program in order to receive the 2009 CDBG Recovery funds from Fulton County for the Norcross Street Drainage & Swaybranch Street Waterline improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the grant award shall be \$125,611 and the purpose of the grant is to provide waterline and street drainage improvements for the benefit of low-to-moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department shall oversee the projects' implementation, administration and closeout. The City shall utilize the CDBG-Recovery 2009 funding totaling \$125,611, as follows: \$105,000 for Swaybranch Road waterline improvements to be administered by the Public Works/Environmental Department, and \$20,611 to be administered by the Transportation Department to correct a drainage issue on Norcross Street at Crestview Circle; and

WHEREAS, the City, under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009, is not required to provide local matching funds:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Roswell that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator are authorized to execute this grant agreement and any subsequent documents necessary to provide the grant funds to the City of Roswell, this the 2nd of November, 2009.
