ALIEN ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SCAAP) GRANT**


**WHEREAS**, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 19<sup>th</sup> of April, 2010, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit an FY2010 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) Grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance; and

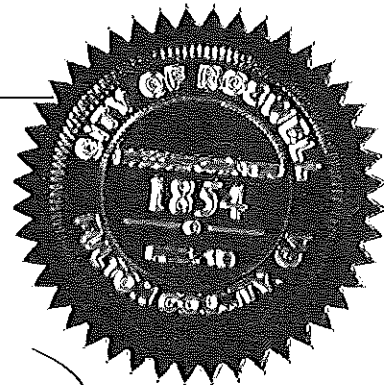
**WHEREAS**, the requested grant award provides federal payments to local governments that incurred correctional officer salary costs for incarcerating undocumented criminal aliens who have at least one felony conviction or two misdemeanor convictions and who are incarcerated for at least four (4) consecutive days during the reporting period. The reporting period for FY2010 is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. The deadline for application for this program is May 7, 2010; and


**WHEREAS**, there are no matching costs associated with this grant. Determination of potential payments will require compilation of eligible inmate days and rate structure for this jurisdiction. For FY07 the average per diem rate was \$30.30 per inmate:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Roswell that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator are authorized to execute this grant application and any subsequent documents necessary to provide the grant funds to the City of Roswell, this the 19<sup>th</sup> of April, 2010.


