**RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A  
FY 2010 BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP (BVP) GRANT APPLICATION**


**WHEREAS**, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 17<sup>th</sup> of May, 2010, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to apply for a FY10 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded, the City of Roswell would receive Nine Thousand (\$9,000) dollars in Federal funding to partially fund the purchase of National Institute of Justice (NIJ) compliant ballistic and stab resistant vests for law enforcement officers; and

**WHEREAS**, the City would be required to provide at least fifty-percent (50%) or Nine Thousand (\$9,000) dollars in local matching funds to come from the Police Department's Operating Budget:


