

**RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A
FY 2009 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) LOCAL FORMULA PROPOSAL**

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 16th of November, 2009, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to accept the terms and conditions of the FY09 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Local Formula Proposal from the U.S. Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell was awarded \$23,958 in Federal funding to purchase law enforcement communications equipment; and

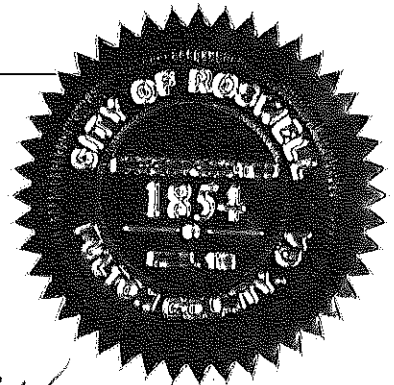
WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has executed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with other Fulton County law enforcement agencies (the City of Atlanta Police Department as the lead agency) on the disparate distribution methodology. The Police Department will be responsible for the implementation, management, reporting and close-out of the grant project; and

WHEREAS, the City is not required to provide local matching funds:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Roswell that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator are authorized to execute this grant agreement and any subsequent documents necessary to provide the grant funds to the City of Roswell, this the 16th of November, 2009.
