## RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FROM OPAL AND THOMAS DRIVE WATERLINE PROJECT TO THE WARSAW ROAD WATERLINE PROJECT

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 27th day of September 2010, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to request a transfer of \$90,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the Opal and Thomas Drive Waterlines project to the Warsaw Road Waterline project; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County administers CDBG program funds for the City of Roswell and has indicated, if approved by Fulton County staff, that these funds are available to transfer without advertising an Annual Action Plan amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City, if granted the transfer, will be able to reduce the amount of City Water Funds for the Warsaw Road Waterline by \$90,000 saving City water user fees for other needed projects:
