WHEREAS, the City of Roswell was proud and honored to be able to offer assistance in rebuilding the capabilities of the Island Park Volunteer Fire Department; and


WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has received an outpouring of gratitude from Island Park residents, Roswell residents and people from around the United States; and
