RESOLUTION REGARDING E 9-1-1 CHARGES

WHEREAS, on March 11, 1991, the Mayor and Council of the City of Roswell adopted a Resolution establishing an Emergency Telephone System Fund; and

WHEREAS, such Resolution authorized and established a monthly 9-1-1 charge for telephone subscribers within the City of Roswell; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council adopted a Resolution on December 21, 1998 as amended on April 16, 2007 pursuant to changes in State law, O.C.G.A. § 46-5-134, authorizing a monthly 9-1-1 charge to each subscriber within the City of Roswell of a wireless enhanced connection; and

WHEREAS, Part 4 of Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated authorizes local governments to impose a 9-1-1 charge upon each voice over internet protocol (VoIP) telecommunications connection subscribed to by subscribers whose billing address is within the jurisdiction of the local government; and

WHEREAS, such charges may be imposed by any local government which operates or contracts for the operation of an emergency 9-1-1 system which is capable of providing or provides automatic number identification and automatic location identification of voice over internet protocol telecommunications connections; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell operates an emergency 9-1-1 system which is capable of providing automatic number identification and automatic location identification of telephone communication connections; and

WHEREAS, such charges may be imposed at a rate of up to \$1.50 per month per voice over internet protocol connection; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to implement a monthly 9-1-1 service charge upon each voice over internet protocol telecommunications connection subscribed to by lay subscribers whose billing address is within the City of Roswell, Georgia, at the rate of \$1.50 per month per VoIP connection provided to each telephone subscriber; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution has been adopted only after at least ten (10) days public notice and a public hearing as required by O.C.G.A. § 46-5-133(b)(1)(B):

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Roswell, and it is hereby resolved that there shall be established a monthly 9-1-1 service charge of \$1.50 during fiscal year 2009–2010 and thereafter per voice over internet protocol

(VoIP) subscriber within the City of Roswell to fund and maintain the Emergency 9-1-1 Fund; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council do hereby reaffirm the necessity for the monthly 9-1-1 charge of \$1.50 per telephone line and \$1.50 per wireless telephone subscribers during fiscal year 2009-2010 and thereafter for the funding and maintenance of the Emergency 9-1-1 Fund.

This Resolution shall become effective November 1, 2009 or one hundred and twenty (120) days after its adoption.
