Dear Mr. Townsend:

We are writing to voice our adamant opposition to the proposed go-kart facility at Andretti's. We own a home in the Darien Park neighborhood which backs up to Houze Road. Consequently, our family will be among the most affected by the obtrusive noise and pollution created by such an establishment.

We urge you to consider how you would personally feel if you had a commercial go-kart track created only a couple of hundred yards from your home. Imagine the equivalent of many loud lawnmowers simultaneously revving their engines, from the early hours of the morning and late into the night. You would rarely be able to have a moment of peace and quiet out in your backyard, or even in your family or kitchen room in the evening. Then think about the additional exhaust fumes and pollution to which your young children must constantly be subjected. The air quality in our area already gets an "F."
