## RESOLUTION SEEKING APPROVAL TO APPLY FOR A 2009 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FORMULA PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 2007, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit a 2009 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula proposal to the U.S. Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Assistance for their consideration; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to submit a formula request seeking an estimated award of \$71,894.01 in Federal funding to purchase law enforcement communications equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with other Fulton County law enforcement agencies (the City of Atlanta Police Department as the lead agency) on the disparate distribution methodology. If the formula grant is selected for an award, the Police Department will be responsible for the implementation, management, reporting and close-out of the grant project; and

WHEREAS, the City, is not required to provide local matching funds from the Grant Match Fund Contingency:
