A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 2 provisions relative to agriculture, so as to preempt certain local ordinances relating to
- 3 production of agricultural or farm products; to protect the right to grow food crops and raise
- 4 small animals on private property so long as such crops and animals are used for human
- 5 consumption by the occupants, gardeners, or raisers and their households and not for
- 6 commercial purposes; to define a term; to provide for effect on certain private agreements
- 7 and causes of action; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Chapter 1 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions
- 11 relative to agriculture, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'crops' means fruits and products of all annual
- or perennial plants, trees, and shrubs.
- 15 (b) No county, municipality, consolidated government, or local government authority shall
- prohibit or require any permit for the growing or raising of food crops or chickens, rabbits,
- 17 or goats in:
- 18 (1) Home gardens, coops, or pens on private residential property so long as such food
- crops or animals or the products thereof are used for human consumption by the occupant
- of such property and members of his or her household and not for commercial purposes;
- 21 <u>and</u>
- 22 (2) Community or cooperative gardens, coops, or pens on any portion of any private lot
- 23 made available for such purposes by the occupant thereof so long as the total lot size is
- not more than 2.75 acres and the food crops or animals or the products thereof are used
- 25 for human consumption by the growers and raisers and members of their households and
- 26 not for commercial purposes.

- (c) This Code section shall not prohibit or impair any private covenant or other private
 agreement restricting the use of real property or any cause of action for a private nuisance
 or trespass; provided, however, that any cause of action for nuisance shall remain subject
 to the provisions of Code Section 41-1-7, if applicable."
- 31 SECTION 2.
- 32 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 33 without such approval.
- 34 SECTION 3.
- 35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
