## RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE FY2014 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG)

**WHEREAS,** at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 25<sup>th</sup> of August, 2014, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to accept the 2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) from the U.S. Department of Justice's (DOJ) Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA); and

**WHEREAS,** the grant award shall be in the amount of \$10,449 and will be used to purchase an Automatic License Plate Reader (ALPR), which will be used to read vehicle license plates and check them against an installed database for rapid identity verification. This tool has proven effective in improving officer efficiency and safety.

**WHEREAS**, the Roswell Police Department will be responsible for the implementation, management, reporting and close-out of the grant project; and

**WHEREAS**, the project budget for this equipment will be \$20,000, and the City will cover the balance of \$9,551 using the grant match contingency fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Roswell that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator are authorized to execute this grant agreement and any subsequent documents necessary to allocate the grant funds, this the 25<sup>th</sup> of August, 2014.
