**RESOLUTION SEEKING APPROVAL TO ACCEPT 2009 COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FOR OPAL DRIVE/THOMAS DRIVE  
WATERLINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 13<sup>th</sup> of April, 2009, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to accept the terms and conditions of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program in order to receive the 2009 CDBG funds from Fulton County for the Opal Drive/Thomas Drive Waterline improvement project; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant award shall be \$462,448 and the purpose of the grant is to provide waterline improvements for the benefit of low-to-moderate income persons; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell desires to utilize these funds for the project approved by the Mayor and City Council, and submitted to Fulton County for inclusion in its 2009 Annual Action Plan to HUD; and


**WHEREAS**, the Community Development Department shall oversee the project implementation, administration and closeout of all CDBG projects in collaboration with the City Environmental and Public Works Department who shall utilize these funds for the Opal Drive/Thomas Drive Waterline project:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Roswell that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator are authorized to execute this grant agreement and any subsequent documents necessary to provide the grant funds to the City of Roswell, this the 13<sup>th</sup> of April, 2009.




