Section 21.1.7 Issuance of a Permit

No application for a development permit shall be approved and no permit shall be issued for any landdisturbing activity inconsistent with requirements of this chapter.

Section 21.1.8 Requirements for Perennial Streams

No application for a development permit shall be approved and no permit shall be issued for any landdisturbing activity within the corridor of any perennial stream within the municipal limits of the City of Roswell unless:

- (a) A buffer is maintained for a distance of one hundred (100) feet on both sides of the stream as measured from the stream banks;
- (b) No impervious surface is constructed within a one hundred fifty-foot setback area on both sides of the stream as measured from the stream banks; and
- (c) Septic tanks and septic tank drainfields are not in the setback area of subsection (b) above.

Section 21.1.9 Requirements for Flowing Streams

No application for a development permit shall be approved and no permit shall be issued for any landdisturbing activity within the corridor of any flowing stream within the municipal limits of the City of Roswell unless:

- (a) A buffer is maintained for a distance of fifty (50) feet on each side of the stream bank as measured horizontally from the stream bank;
- (b) No impervious surface is constructed within a seventy-five-foot setback along each side of the stream bank as measured horizontally from the stream bank; and
- (c) Septic tanks or septic tank drain fields are not located within one hundred fifty (150) feet of the stream bank.
