ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF ROSWELL ZONING ORDINANCE TO ALLOW AS A CONDITIONAL USE IN THE O-P ZONING DISTRICT THE USES OF ANIMAL HOSPITALS AND VETERINARY CLINICS

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell now desires to amend the Zoning Ordinance with regard to the use of animal hospitals and veterinary clinics; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that the use of animal hospitals and veterinary clinics should be allowed as a conditional use in the O-P zoning district:

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to their authority, the Mayor and City Council adopt the following ordinance:

1.

The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Roswell is hereby amended to allow the uses of animal hospitals and veterinary clinics as a conditional use in the O-P zoning district by changing Table 6.1 as follows:

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to municipal governing authorities in Chapter 35 of Title 36 of the O.C.G.A., known as the *Municipal Home Rule Act of 1965*.

All ordinances, parts of ordinances and regulations in conflict here are repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

4.

It is the intention of the Mayor and Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Zoning Ordinance, City of Roswell, Georgia and the sections of such text may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

5.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its adoption on <u>Manuform 14</u>, 2009, the public welfare demanding it.
