

**RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE NAME OF FRAZIER STREET
TO FRASER STREET**

WHEREAS, The City of Roswell procedure for renaming a street adopted by Resolution dated June 19, 1995 provides for a process for renaming of streets by the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, The City of Roswell received a signed petition from 100% of the adjacent owners stating they had no objection to a name change or desired the street name to remain as is for consideration and the City advertised and considered the proposed and other names in an open public meeting scheduled for the purpose; and

WHEREAS, in due process the City determined the original name was intended to show respect for one of Roswell’s earliest settlers, “Simon Fraser” as was documented upon a Plat and survey by C.E. Abercrombie, a registered land surveyor in the State of Georgia, dated March 19, 1963; as well as by testimony from Gary Fraser, resident, and descendant of Simon Fraser along with documentation of their family history now provided to the Roswell Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council of Roswell do now desire that the street name should remain the name as originally intended:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Roswell that the City of Roswell officially designates “Fraser” Street in memory of Simon Fraser and that the Roswell Department of Transportation is authorized to execute the designation of said street on or about January 1, 2015 to enable the adjacent owners the opportunity to accommodate said change as the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the citizens of Roswell requires.
