**RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT THE FY2013 JUSTICE
ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) LOCAL PROPOSAL**

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 24th of June 2013, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit an application for the 2013 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) from the U.S. Department of Justice's (DOJ) Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA); and

WHEREAS, the grant award shall be in the amount of \$10,604 and will be used to purchase an Automatic License Plate Reader (ALPR), which will enhance officer efficiency, improve officer safety and provide information for better intelligence gathering; and

WHEREAS, The Roswell Police Department will be responsible for the implementation, management, reporting and close-out of the grant project; and

WHEREAS, the project budget for this equipment is \$20,000, and the City will cover the balance of \$9,396 using the grant match contingency fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Roswell that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator are authorized to execute this grant application and any subsequent documents necessary to apply for the grant funds, this the 24th of June, 2013.
