### RESOLUTION TO ABANDON PORTION OF ELIZABETH LANE

WHEREAS, the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 32-7-1 authorize a municipality, whenever it is deemed in the public interest, to abandon any public road that is under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 32-7-4 sets forth the procedure for disposition of such property; and

WHEREAS, William S. Logan and Kathryn V. Logan have requested that the City of Roswell abandon a portion of Elizabeth Lane abutting property owned by the Logans on either side of Elizabeth Lane and a further portion of Elizabeth Lane abutted by property owned by Ernest F. Hansberger and Victoria F. Hansberger, all as shown on that plat of survey and legal descriptions collectively attached to this resolution Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, Ernest F. Hansberger and Victoria F. Hansberger have stated that they consent to the abandonment and do not wish to take any property from the abandonment, but, in fact, wish for William S. Logan and Kathryn V. Logan to take possession of all of the public road to be abandoned; and

WHEREAS, William S. Logan and Kathryn V. Logan desire to construct a shop on their property and need the area of the proposed road abandonment to satisfy requirements for septic service; and

WHEREAS, there no longer is a public purpose in maintaining the portion of Elizabeth Lane proposed for abandonment;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Roswell that the City of Roswell abandon any interest in and to the road/right of way described in the attached Exhibit "A" and that the Mayor is authorized to execute a quitclaim deed in favor of William S. Logan and Kathryn V. Logan or said owners' successors in title.



## LEGAL DESCRIPTION

BEGINNING at an iron pin found on the Northerly right-of-way line of Elizabeth Lane 289.5 feet Easterly from the Easterly right-of-way line of Crabapple Road (said Easterly right-of-way line being located 42.0 feet from centerline of Crabapple Road); thence, North 89°11'00" East, along said Northerly right-of-way line of Elizabeth Lane, a distance of 104.10 feet to an iron pin found; thence, South 00°41'00" East a distance of 12.175 feet to a point; thence South 89°33'47" West a distance of 104.10 feet to a point; thence, North 00°41'00" West a distance of 11.485 feet to an iron pin found and the Point of Beginning.

BEGINNING at an iron pin found on the Northerly right-of-way line of Elizabeth Lane 393.9 feet Easterly from the Easterly right-of-way line of Crabapple Road (said Easterly right-of-way line being located 42.0 feet from centerline of Crabapple Road); thence, North 89°11'00" East, along said Northerly right-of-way line of Elizabeth Lane, a distance of 82.10 feet to an iron pin found; thence, South 00°29'00" West a distance of 25.44 feet to an iron pin found on the Southerly right-of-way line of Elizabeth Lane (r/w varies); thence South 89°56'42" West along said Southerly right-of-way line of Elizabeth Lane a distance of 81.59 feet to a point; thence, continuing along said Southerly right-of-way line of Elizabeth Lane (r/w varies), South 89°56'42" West a distance of 104.11 feet to a point; thence, North 00°41'00" West a distance of 11.485 feet to a point; thence, North 89°33'47" East a distance of 104.10 feet to a point; thence, North 00°41'00" West a distance of 12.175 feet to an iron pin found and the Point of Beginning.
