- WHEREAS,** In July 1969, Stuart A. Moring began his career and served our country honorably as a U.S. Navy Civil Engineer Corps Officer in the Seabees, in Vietnam and Guantanamo Bay, Cuba; and
- WHEREAS,** In 1974, Mr. Moring continued his education and received Masters Degrees in City Planning and Civil Engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology; and
- WHEREAS,** During Mr. Moring's career, he has served his peers in the following professional organizations: President of the Georgia Chapter, American Public Works Association (APWA); President of the Georgia Section, American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE); Regional Governor of ASCE; served on National Committees of both APWA and ASCE, and the Georgia Association of Water Professionals (GAWP); and
- WHEREAS,** In 2003, Mr. Moring was selected as Georgia Engineer of the Year in Government by the Georgia Engineering Alliance, and was selected a Top Ten Public Works Leader of the Year in 2007 and a Public Works Leadership Fellow by the American Public Works Association; and
- WHEREAS,** Since August 1997, during Mr. Moring's tenure with the City of Roswell, the City has received numerous awards for excellence in water treatment - Water Distribution System of the Year, Stormwater Program of the Year, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency RCRA Resource Conservation Partner of the Year, the Keep America Beautiful President's Circle Award, certification as a National Wildlife Habitat Community, and selection as a Georgia WaterFirst Community; and
- WHEREAS,** The motto of the Environmental/Public Works Department is Public Works WORKS and numerous citizens have written letters and e-mails expressing appreciation for the work of the Department under Stu's leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Moring has served the City of Roswell for 17 years with distinction, fairness and integrity, promoting the sustainability objectives of economy, environment and citizen service; and
- WHEREAS,** Stuart A. Moring will retire on August 29, 2014 after an engineering career spanning 45 years. Stuart looks forward to focusing on community and international volunteer activities and traveling with his wife, Gay, of 43 glorious years.
