ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE 2.6, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, SECTION 2.6.3, TERMS OF OFFICE, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL BY ADDING SECTION 2.6.3.1, STAGGERING TERMS

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council constitute the governing authority of the City of Roswell, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to amend its Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council have reviewed the proposed change to Section 2.6.3 by adding a new Section 2.6.3.1 to achieve the staggering of terms:

NOW, THEREFORE, to accomplish the foregoing the Mayor and Council pursuant to their authority, adopt the following ordinance:

1.

The Code of Ordinances of the City of Roswell, Article 2.6, *Boards and Commissions*, Section 2.6.3 *Terms of Office*, shall be amended by adding a new Section 2.6.3.1, *Staggering Terms* to follow Section 2.6.3 to read as follows:

Section 2.6.3.1 Staggering Terms. Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 2.6.3, if the terms of a majority of the members of any board or commission expire in the same month, then Mayor & Council may extend the term of any board member by one or two years to create staggered terms, thereby allowing for greater continuity of experience on the board or commission involved. This Section 2.6.3.1 shall automatically be repealed at close of business on December 31, 2014.

2.

Severability. Should any section of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or regulations in conflict herewith are repealed.



Renumbering. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Roswell, Georgia and the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.


This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its adoption, the public welfare demanding it.
