## RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A FY 2009 BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP GRANT AWARD

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 16<sup>th</sup> of November, 2009, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to accept the terms and conditions of the FY09 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance; and
