I have attached a map of the properties we own in the vicinity of our church. All of the properties are identified in yellow and we have indicated the current use of each with the exception of 5 properties. They are as follows:

1. 944 Myrtle Street – We are proposing to use this property as the location for a Youth Center
2. 169 Norcross Street (on the Southwest corner of Norcross and Myrtle Streets). Future use undetermined. Current use is parking.
3. 183 Norcross Street (on the Southeast corner of Norcross and Myrtle Streets). Current use: Office Building housing church related ministries and parking.
4. 961 Zion Circle, Lot 41 (Residential – currently tenant occupied)
5. 839 Myrtle Street/816 Zion Circle (Lot 4) and 851 Myrtle Street (Lot 24) are currently used for parking. This property is adjacent to the new church site @ 888 Zion Circle across the creek bed and near the corner of Myrtle Street and Zion Circle

Deacon Byrd,

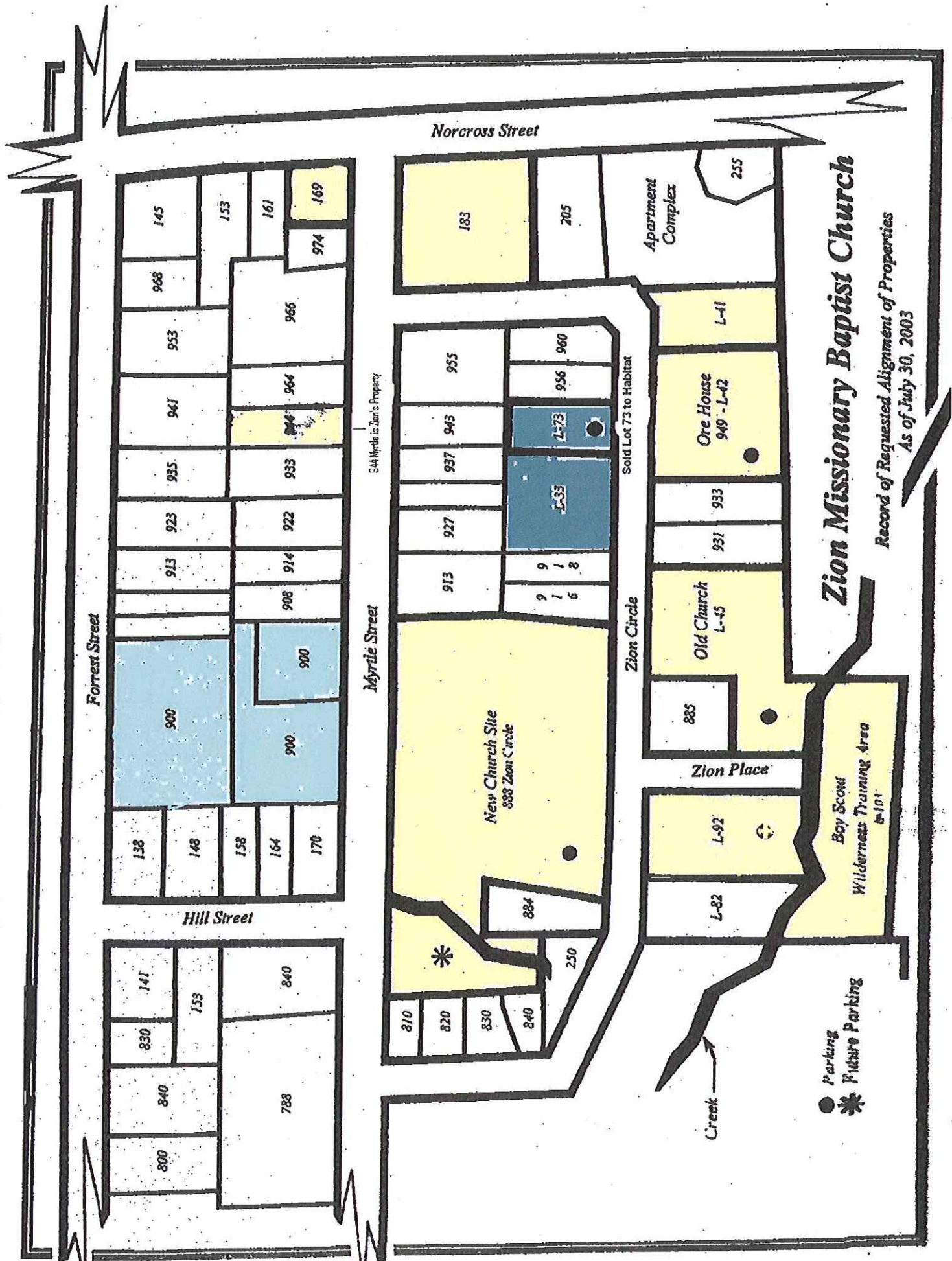
