Upon a determination such actions would be in its best interest, the City of Roswell, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to:

- Cancel or terminate this ITB at any time. A notice of cancellation will be issued on the Roswell
 website. If the ITB is cancelled, the City of Roswell will not reimburse any Offeror for the
 preparation of its bid. Bids may be returned upon request if unopened;
- Reject any or all bids received in response to this ITB,
- Make a contract award, based directly on the bids received, determined to be in the best interest of the City, in its sole discretion,
- Enter into further discussions with one or more Offerors;
- Waive and/or amend any undesirable, inconsequential, or inconsistent provisions/specifications of this ITB which would not have significant impact on any bid;
- Not award if it is in the best interest of the City of Roswell; or
- Terminate any contract if the City of Roswell determines adequate funds are not available.

SECTION 3: SCOPE OF PROJECT/SPECIFICATIONS

3.1 City's Intent

The City of Roswell is accepting bids for the furnishing of all materials, labor, and equipment for the completion of an improvement project that will result in the renovation and addition of an Event Facility at the Roswell Old Mill Park Machine Shop located at 95 Mill View Avenue Roswell, GA 30075.

3.2 Required Information : Scope of Work and Design Intent

Scope of Work:

The scope of work calls for the creation of an Event Facility to be located within the Roswell Mill Park at Vickery Creek. The need for this amenity has been generated by high use of this park since becoming open for public use in 2009. The Event Facility will compliment recent addition of three new board walks, trails and restrooms that allow park visitors to safely view the ruins of the 1854 circa Roswell Mill Manufacturing Company Mill site. The Mill site is included within the National Register of Historic Places- listed within the Roswell Historic District.

Proposed Building Structure / Design Intent:

The following items were addressed to assist in establishing design considerations for this building exterior structure, while having to incorporate elements that are required for its use, which are available budget, access, security and ADA access requirements. The details utilized from the existing historic circa 1854 Brick Machine Shop Building are intended to show precedence for Architectural Material Selection and Design Elements for the proposed Event Facility and limited building renovation.

- The main level floor elevation for the adjacent Brick (Machine) Shop Building is (902.41'). The existing floor elevation is 2.41' below the pathway way at the east side of the Machine Shop Building and is level at the west side of the Machine shop that is closest to the covered bridge.
- During the planning and construction of the circa 2012 restrooms that were built adjacent to the
 historic circa 1854 it was determined to have shutters that would have been utilized during that
 era in order to protect the new window infill that would be eventually installed on the Event
 Facility improvements with regard to security.
- The current set of plans that were developed to improve and stabilize various structural and brick components along with utilizing the main area for Events while allowing the original structure to be interpreted for the buildings original purpose of being a water-powered Machine and Wood Working Shop.
- Gutter and Downspouts. It is doubtful that the original buildings would have had gutters and
 downspouts due to the utility nature of the structure. However, due to the need to keep the area
 maintained and accessible, half round gutter and round down spout system was utilized in a
 previous improvement campaign and will remain until future improvements to be the building are
 determined.
- Exterior: Solid Core Doors have been proposed that would have been utilized for industrial and warehouse type building during that era. The door profiled door and casing was selected to satisfy maintenance and security needs. The door selected has a double 'vertical' panel with angled stile support that is 'similar' to door panels of the era, although an industrial door of that time may be more keeping, yet it would have to be custom manufactured.
- Brick: Brick repair and colored mortar joint replacement will be limited. This detail is illustrated in the architectural plans.
- Shutters: Operable Shutters with period wrought iron hardware will match the adjacent existing circa 2012 brick restrooms.
- Windows: True divided light, operable double hung wood window are designed for the window openings. On the elevation nearest the bridge on the lower level, the windows are designed to be triple hung.
- Louvers: Louvers as shown on the plans and elevations are to be located on the upper level in order to assist the function of exhaust fans.

1. For those vendors that bid on this project during the first bid, Can the City/Architect elaborate/list changes that were made to the plans?

Response:

- Changes were made to reduce the scope in order to reduce the cost. Areas that
 were addressed were elimination of exterior ground lighting and disturbance of
 existing pavers, reduction of exterior/joint repair, deleted removal of graffiti on
 interior walls(to white washed by Owner), New interior stud wall/finish,
 base/crown/casing to be by Owner, deleted suspended heaters, reduced the
 number of interior light fixtures and electrical outlets, deleted plumbing and
 kitchen millwork and associated electrical, deleted removal of existing fencing.
 This list is not complete and contractors will bid the revised plans that were
 posted for bid.
- 2. Are there any acceptable equivalents to the custom triple hung sash unit windows.? **Response:**
 - The windows are to be prices as approved by the HPC.
- 3. Are there any vendors that you would recommend to get a quote from fro the custom windows?

Response:
