**RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A
FY2012 FIRE PREVENTION AND SAFETY GRANT PROPOSAL**

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 25th of March 2013, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit a FY2012 Fire Prevention and Safety (FP&S) grant proposal for consideration by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, the Fire Prevention and Safety grant is part of FEMA's Assistance to Firefighter's Grant program to support projects that enhance the safety of the public and firefighters from fire and related hazards. The primary goal of FP&S is to reduce injury and prevent death among high-risk populations. The Roswell Fire Department is seeking \$52,000 in Federal grant funds for the purchase of dedicated vehicle to tow the Fire and Life Safety Center for a total project request of \$60,000. The tow vehicle is necessary to continue our educational and outreach efforts in the community; and


WHEREAS, if the grant is selected for an award, the Roswell Fire Department will be responsible for the implementation, management, reporting and close-out of the grant project; and


WHEREAS, the City, is required to provide local matching funds not to exceed \$13,000 from the Grant Match Fund Contingency:




