RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A
2013 GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 11th of March 2013, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit a grant proposal for consideration by the Governor's Office of Highway Safety; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) is offering state funding to qualifying law enforcement agencies for the purchase of an 'Intoxilyzer 9000.' The equipment is necessary to remain in compliance with Georgia State law. The Roswell Police Department will continue GOHS reporting and participation in the State's Traffic Enforcement Network. The City of Roswell is seeking the intoxilyzer equipment, training and shipping valued at \$8,000; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is selected for an award, the Roswell Police Department will be responsible for the implementation, management, reporting and close-out of the grant project; and

WHEREAS, the City, is not required to provide local matching funds from the Grant Match Fund Contingency:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Roswell that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator are authorized to execute this grant application and any subsequent documents necessary to apply for the grant funds, this the 11th of March, 2013.
