**RESOLUTION SEEKING APPROVAL TO ACCEPT A
2009 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FORMULA PROPOSAL**

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 20th day of July 2009, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to the terms and conditions of the 2009 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula grant from the U.S. Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell was awarded \$71,894.01 in Federal funding to purchase law enforcement communications equipment; and


WHEREAS, the City of Roswell is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with other Fulton County law enforcement agencies (the City of Atlanta Police Department as the lead agency) on the disparate distribution methodology. The Police Department will be responsible for the implementation, management, reporting and close-out the grant project; and

WHEREAS, the City is not required to provide local matching funds from the Grant Match Fund Contingency:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator is authorized to execute this grant agreement and any subsequent documents necessary to provide the grant funds to the City of Roswell, this the 20th day of July 2009.




