RESOLUTION SEEKING APPROVAL TO SUBMIT FY 2011 FEDERAL APPROPRIATIONS REQUESTS

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 1st day of March 2010, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit a FY 2011 Federal Appropriations request; and

WHEREAS, the City recently received the FY2011 Federal Appropriation forms for Senator Chambliss and the following projects will be presented for consideration for Federal funds for eligible expenses pertaining to:

- Historic District Light Fixture Replacement Project Estimated cost \$805,000;
- Atlanta Street Corridor Improvements Estimated cost \$20,000,000;
- Combat Childhood Obesity and Promote Prevention and Wellness Estimated cost \$150,000;
- Water Rescue, Special Operations, Search and Rescue, and Emergency Operations -Estimated cost \$216,570;
- Water Supply Intake Rehab Design and Construction Estimated cost \$500,000;
- Big-Creek Sub-Basin Rehab Estimated cost \$500,000-\$700,000;
- Development of Water Supply Elevated Tank Estimated Cost \$1,000,000;
- Fire Hydrant Backflow Program Estimated cost \$1,000,000;
- Economic Development Estimated cost \$1,000,000.

WHEREAS, the City, may be required to provide local matching funds up to 25% of the total amount should the Federal Appropriations be selected for an award and accepted by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Departments shall oversee the projects implementation, administration and closeout:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City that the Mayor of Roswell and/or the City Administrator is authorized to execute the grant application and any subsequent documents necessary to provide the grant funds to the City of Roswell, this the 1st day of March, 2010.
