DEAR MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS,

THANK YOU ALL FOR THE GREAT WORK YOU ARE DOING IN CONTINUING THE PRESERVATION OF KEEPING ROSWELL A VERY ATTRACTIVE ENVIRONMENT WITH AN ENVIABLE QUALITY OF LIFE.

RESIDENTS IN THE NEIGHBORHOODS ALONG CRABAPPLE ROAD AND CROSSVILLE ROAD FEEL STRONGLY THAT THE PRESENCE OF A RACE TRAC CONVENIENCE STORE WITH 18 GAS PUMPS OPERATING 24 HOURS A DAY, SEVEN DAYS A WEEK WITH THE CONSTRUCTION PROCESS REQUIRING 7 MAJOR CODE VARIANCES WILL CAUSE SIGNIFICANT ADVERSE IMPACTS ON OUR WELFARE AND QUALITY OF LIFE.

THE RESIDENTS IN NEARBY NEIGHBORHOODS ASK THE ROSWELL CITY COUNCIL TO DENY THESE VARIANCES REQUESTED BY THE UNITED STATES POST OFFICE AND RACE TRAC PETROLEUM, INC. (COLLECTIVELY "THE APPLICANT"). WE FEEL OUR CONCERNS ARE VALID AND ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE RESIDENT'S RIGHTS OUTLINED IN THE CITY CODE RELATING TO CAUSING DETRIMENT, NUISANCE AND ANNOYANCE, THE COMFORT AND REPOSE. IN ADDITION, WE FEEL THAT APPROVING THE 7 MAJOR VARIANCES THAT ARE REQUIRED - REMOVAL OF THE MAJORITY OF THE UNDERGROWTH AND MANY OF THE TREES WITHIN THE 50-FOOT <u>UNDISTURBED</u> STREAM BUFFER AND INSTALLING IMPERVIOUS MATERIALS IN THE MAJORITY OF THE 75-FOOT <u>NO IMPERVIOUS MA</u>TERIALS BUFFER - IS UNACCEPTABLE.

THE OPERATIONS OF THIS CONVENIENCE STORE WITH IS PUMPS WILL ENDANGER THE VALUES OF REAL PROPERTY OF ADJACENT RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITIES. THE OPERATIONS WILL GENERATE NOISE - VEHICLES, PEOPLE, PUMPS - 24/7 AND THE LIGHTING - ENTRANCES, EXITS, PARKING, PUMP CANOPY, STORE AND VEHICLE HEADLIGHTS - WILL BE REAL PROBLEMS.

PREVIOUSLY, PROBLEMS WITH LIGHTING FROM THE POST OFFICE FACILITY WERE EXPERIENCED AND POST OFFICE MANAGEMENT RESOLVED THE PROBLEMS. THE LIGHTING PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS 24/7 HIGH TRAFFIC ENVIRONMENT CANNOT BE RESOLVED.

HOME SALES IN NEARBY NEIGHBORHOODS ARE CREATING SEVERE FINANCIAL PROBLEMS FOR HOME OWNERS TODAY. CAN YOU IMAGINE WHAT THEY WOULD BE WITH THE PROPOSED ENVIRONMENT.
