WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States on August 3, 1949, officially designated June 14th of each year as "National Flag Day"; and

WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States on June 20, 1965, adopted a Joint Resolution approved by the President, to recognize a pause for the Pledge of Allegiance as part of National Flag Day ceremonies and urged all Americans to participate; and

WHEREAS, The City of Roswell, has always been proud of our National Flag and what it symbolizes, knowing that it stands for the best that humankind has ever sought and achieved in the history of this world.
