**RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A 2012 APPLICATION TO THE GEORGIA
INITIATIVE FOR COMMUNITY HOUSING**

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 12th of September, 2012, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit a 2012 technical assistance Georgia Initiative for Community Housing application to the University of Georgia Housing and Demographics Research Center; and

WHEREAS, the requested technical assistance will be in the form assistance from University of Georgia, Georgia Department of Community Affairs, and the Georgia Municipal Association of collaboration to create a locally-based plan to meet housing and neighborhood revitalization needs; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia recognize the importance of housing access to the social and economic well-being of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to increase its commitment to solving the housing issues facing its residents; and


WHEREAS, the City has evidenced this commitment through recent infrastructure improvements and financial support for a Low-Income Housing Tax Credit project; and

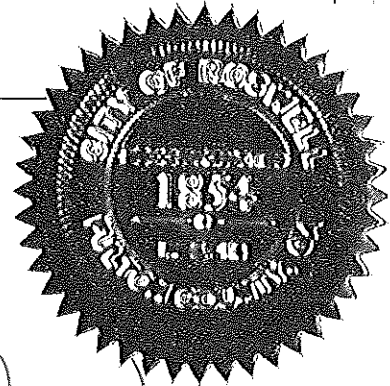
WHEREAS, the City seeks to increase the knowledge and tools available to address housing attainment for its workforce needs by participating in the Georgia Initiative for Community Housing; and

WHEREAS, if awarded funding the City will provide \$1,000 funds per year for staff and elected official participation for travel from the Grant Match Fund Contingency; and


WHEREAS, if the technical assistance application is selected, the Community Development Department shall oversee the project's implementation, administration and closeout:
