**RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE CREATION OF THE HOLCOMB BRIDGE 400
LIVABLE CENTER INITIATIVE (LCI) AREA**

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Regional Commission's (ARC) Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) program allows communities with existing master plans to be "grandfathered" into the program if the plan meets the LCI criteria; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell, Georgia, has completed three planning studies addressing the future land use and transportation improvements in the Holcomb Bridge Road at SR 400 interchange area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell, Georgia, has approved the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, the Strategic Economic Development Plan, and the HBR Corridor Study; and

WHEREAS, communities requesting that existing studies are considered as sufficient to enter the LCI program for implementation funding shall provide documentation to ARC for consideration; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell, Georgia, prepared the Holcomb Bridge 400 Livable Center Initiative Study summarizing how the three planning studies adequately reflect the goals and intent of the LCI program:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Roswell the City of Roswell supports the creation of the new Holcomb Bridge 400 LCI area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution and Holcomb Bridge 400 Livable Center Initiative Study shall be submitted to the Atlanta Regional Commission for their consideration.
