19	Chapter 10 Licenses, Taxes & Business Regulations, of the Roswell Code of Ordinances is

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21 22	10.15.1 - Definitions.		
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21 22 23 24	10.15.1 - Definitions.A. <u><i>Commissary</i></u> shall mean an approved catering establishment, restaurant, or other approved place in		
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1 10.15.2 - License required.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, or offer for sale, food of any type from a commissary, mobile retail food establishment, pushcart or temporary food establishment without a license first having
been granted under this section, except for city_-sponsored events.

B. An application for a license or a permit hereunder shall be submitted to the Community
Development Director or his or her designee setting forth all information required hereunder and in
compliance with this ordinance. The Community Development Director or his or her designee shall
develop a form of application for the purpose of compliance with this article.

9 C. The following information shall be provided with each application for a mobile food vendor permit:

- 10 1. Name of the Mobile Food Vendor
- 11 2. Make, model, and license plate number of vending unit
- 12 3. Owner's contact information
- 13 4. Operator's contact information
- 14 5. Type of vendor (street vending unit or sidewalk vending unit)
- 15 6. Copy of approved permit from the Fulton County Health Department
- 16 7. List of operating locations and times
- 17 8. Signatures from property owners indicating consent for the use of their property
- 18 9. Signature <u>of applicant</u> indicating agreement to the listed requirements

19 10.15.3 - Prohibited conduct and requirements.

A. <u>Except for ice cream trucks, The-no</u>mobile food vendor shall not-conduct business or operate under this article on <u>in</u> the public right-of-way-except for ice cream trucks.

B. The <u>A</u> mobile food vendor shall not operate on any private property without the prior consent of
 the owners.

C. <u>The A</u> mobile food vendor shall maintain a \$1,000,000.00 liability <u>insurance</u> policy. Proof of current liability insurance, issued by an insurance company licensed to do business in <u>the stateGeorgia</u>, protecting the <u>licenseemobile food vendor</u>, the public and the city from all claims for damage to property and bodily injury, including death, which may arise from operation under or in connection with the permit. Such insurance shall name the city as an additional insured and shall provide that the policy shall not terminate or be canceled prior to the expiration dated without 30 days¹ advanced written notice to the city.

D. The Except for ice cream trucks, a mobile food vendor shall not emit, outery, speaker, amplifier or
 announcements make sounds or announcements to call attention to the mobile food vehicle either while
 traveling on the public rights-of-way or when stationary. and at-At all times said mobile food vender
 vendor shall be in compliance with the City of Roswell noise ordinance.

35 FE. The license under which a mobile food vendor is operating must be firmly attached and visible on
36 the mobile food vendor or pushcart at all times.

37 <u>GF. In addition, the Roswell Police Department may refuse to issue any permit to any applicant whose</u>
 38 record shows one or more convictions for an alcohol related offense within the previous 12-month

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1 2	traffic violations. Any driver of a mobile food vendor motorized vehicle must possess a valid Georgia driver's license.
3 4 5	HG. The business use must be a use that is otherwise allowed within the zoning district in which the vendor proposes to operate except for ice cream trucks. Except for ice cream trucks, mobile food vendors are allowed only in commercial zoning districts.
6 7	H. Mobile food vendors shall not be located within 15 feet of any street intersection or pedestrian crosswalk or 10 feet of any driveway.
8 9	KI . No sale or offer for sale shall be made by any <u>licensee-mobile food vendor</u> between 9:00 pm and 6:30 am unless such sale is in conjunction with a City approved special event or film production permit.
10 11	LJ. Vending structures shall not be left unattended or stored at any time on the open vending site when vending is not taking place or during restricted hours of operation.
12 13 14	MK . No sale or offer for sale of ice cream, frozen milk, frozen dairy or ice confection products shall be made from a mobile food vendor unless each side of the vehicle is marked, in letters and numbers at least three inches in height, with the name and address of the mobile food vendor licensee.
15 16 17	NL. The mobile food vendor shall comply with all state, federal and local health and safety regulations and requirements and shall obtain and maintain any and all licenses required by any other health, organization or governmental organization having jurisdiction over this subject matter.

 ΘM . The following safety regulations shall apply to any and all vehicles operating under this article or 18 used for mobile retail food establishments: 19

1. Every vehicle shall be equipped with a reverse gear signal alarm with a sound distinguishable 20 21 from the surrounding noise level.

22 2. Every vehicle shall be equipped with two rear-vision mirrors, one at each side, firmly attached to the outside of the motor vehicle, and so located as to reflect to the driver a view of the highway 23 to the rear, along both sides of the vehicle. 24

PN. The mobile food vendor may sell food and non-alcoholic beverage items only. 25

10.15.4 - Indemnity. 26

As part of the permitting process set forth herein, any person or entity receiving a permit set forth herein 27 shall execute an indemnity agreement indemnifying and releasing the City of Roswell, its agents, 28 employees and elected officials from any and all liability against any and all claims, actions and suits of 29 30 any type whatsoever.

31 10.15.5 - Revocation and suspension.

The city shall have the right to revoke or suspend any license granted hereunder. 32

- 10.15.6 Fee. 33
- The fee for every application for license under this section shall be set by resolution. 34
