**RESOLUTION SEEKING APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A  
SECTION 319(h) FY2011 GRANT PROPOSAL**


**WHEREAS**, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 22nd day of November 2010, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit a FY2011 Section 319(h) grant application for a Nonpoint Source Implementation Grant to the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD); and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell desires to submit a proposal seeking a maximum of \$272,400 (60%) in federal funding for the implementation of the Hog Waller Creek Best Management Practices (BMP) Demonstration Project – Dobbs Drive Parking Lot Watershed Improvement. The project will redevelop the Dobbs Drive municipal complex parking lot to include watershed management BMPs to improve the water quality of one of the City's impaired streams. The project's total proposed costs are estimated at \$457,500; and


**WHEREAS**, the City, if selected to receive the grant award, is required to provide a minimum of 40% or \$185,100 of the project's total cost in local matching funds from the Grant Match Fund Contingency:




