RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A
FY12 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 25th day of June, 2012, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit a FY12 Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) proposal to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency, Grant Programs Directorate (GPD) for their consideration;


WHEREAS, the purpose of AFG program is to enhance through financial assistance the safety of the public and firefighters regarding fire and fire-related hazards;


WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to submit a proposal seeking \$44,000 in Federal funding for the purchase and installation of "Vehicle Exhaust Extraction Systems" at Fire Stations three and six. The stations were selected based on need and the fact that the stations are fully staffed and operated 24-hours a day. The project's total costs are estimated at \$55,000;


WHEREAS, the City, if selected to receive the Award, is required to provide \$11,000 or twenty-percent (20%) of the project's total cost in local matching funds from the Grant Match Fund Contingency; and


