## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ROSWELL TO CREATE AND APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE (CPAC) FOR THE CITY OF ROSWELL 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council for the City of Roswell, Georgia (the City) is the duly elected authority for the City; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Planning Act of 1989, Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures require that the City Comprehensive Plan be updated every ten years in accordance with the Local Comprehensive Plan Recertification; and

WHEREAS, the recertification deadline for the City's Comprehensive Plan is October 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the minimum planning standards require that the comprehensive plan shall include three components: (1) Community Assessment, (2) Community Participation Program, and (3) Community Agenda; and

WHEREAS, the Community Participation Program is a key component of the plan development to ensure adequate public and stakeholder involvement in the preparation of the Community Agenda; and

WHEREAS, to ensure successful participation the creation of an advisory committee is necessary:

**NOW, THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Roswell, pursuant to their authority, do hereby create the Comprehensive Advisory Committee (CPAC), made up of citizens, business owners and stakeholders as follows:

**Section 1**. The CPAC will meet with the Consultant and Staff on a periodic basis to review draft materials and make recommendations regarding the various components of the Comprehensive plan.

**Section 2**: The CPAC members shall serve until the completion of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan Update.
