RESOLUTION TO ABANDON PORTION OF CHARLES PLACE

WHEREAS, the provision of O.C. G.A. section 32-7-1 authorize a municipality, whenever it is deemed in the public interest, to abandon any public road that is under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A SS 32-7-4 sets forth the procedure for disposition of such property; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Education is the owner of property on both sides of the described portion of Charles Place; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Education is planning to build a new elementary school at a site bounded by Alpharetta Street to the north, Thomas Drive to the West and Charles Place generally to the south, and

WHEREAS, in exchange for that portion of Charles Place, as indicated in the attached Exhibit "A" consisting of a legal description and survey of the area of Charles Place to be abandoned, the Fulton County Board of Education agrees to dedicate to the City of Roswell a realigned Right of Way as indicated in attached Exhibit "B" consisting of a legal description and survey of the area for a realigned Charles Place to be dedicated, and

WHEREAS, this exchange is, mutually beneficial to the Fulton County Board of Education and to the City of Roswell;

NOW THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Mayor and Council of the City of Roswell that the City of Roswell abandon any interest in and to the road/right of way described in the attached Exhibit "A" and that the Mayor is authorized to execute a quitclaim deed in favor of the owner of the abutting property or said owner's successors in title.
