**RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A
2012 PUBLIC SAFETY TARGET GRANT**

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of Roswell, Georgia, held on the 30th of May 2012, a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Roswell, Georgia agrees to submit a 2012 Public Safety Grant proposal for consideration by Target™ Corporation;

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell is seeking \$5,000 in Local/Private funding to purchase eligible public safety project expenses;

WHEREAS, the online applications must be completed by a law enforcement/public agency or 501(C)(3) nonprofit organization and approved for submission to Target by the highest-ranking official in the agency/organization. If the application is selected for an award, the Roswell Police Department will be responsible for the implementation, management, reporting and close-out of the grant project;

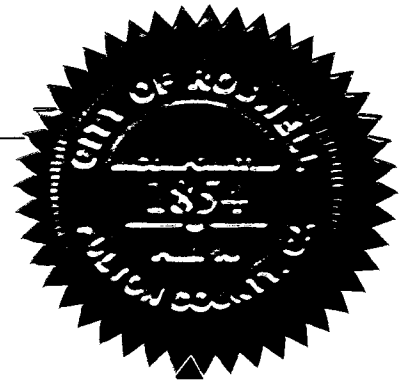
WHEREAS, the City, is not required to provide local matching funds from the Grant Match Fund Contingency; and
